



Kills head lice and nits (lice-eggs) in a single treatment

What is Licener?

Licener is a head lice treatment that kills head lice and nits (lice-eggs) in a single treatment. Licener has proven its effectiveness through clinical studies on children suffering from head lice. The shampoo is soft on the skin and hair, does not sting, and does not contain chemical smelling components. The active ingredient in Licener is the natural Neem-extract, originating from the Neem tree. Licener is easy to use and works rapidly by a mechanical mode of action, in only 10 minutes with no combing required.

Licener consists of:

1. A 100ml bottle with Licener shampoo, which is based on the ingredients:
Neem-extract, Aqua, Polyglyceryl-3 Caprate, Cocamidopropyl Betaine, Glyceryl Laurate, Glycerin, Lauryl Glucoside, Dicaprylyl Ether, Lauryl Alcohol, Benzyl Alcohol, Benzoic Acid, Sorbic Acid, Dimethyl Glutarate and Dimethyl Adipate.
2. This information leaflet containing all the information you need to know about head lice and how to use Licener. Keep this leaflet for your reference.

How does Licener work?

The shampoo contains the active ingredient Neem-extract. This extract ensures that the breathing apparatus of the lice are blocked, whereby the oxygen transportation is disrupted. The lice will suffocate within only a few minutes. The extract also completely covers the nits/head lice eggs and the protective shell of the nits is broken down. In this way Licener kills both the lice and nits in only 1 treatment.

What is head lice?

Head lice are bloodsucking insects without wings. They are parasites that feed on human blood. Head lice and nits prefer warm and dark places on the scalp. Therefore, they are often found behind the ears, along the hairline and the neck. The colour of the lice can vary from sandy-coloured to nearly black. After they have fed on blood they become dark red. The life cycle has three stages: eggs, nymphs and adults. The female louse attaches the eggs to the hair with a kind of glue, no more than 1 mm from the scalp. The eggs take 7 to 10 days to hatch. The development from nymph to lice takes approximately 7 days. The adult female lice can then lay up to 8 eggs per day.

How to use Licener?

STEP 1: Apply Licener shampoo to **dry** hair. Use sufficient shampoo to cover all of the hair. Depending on the length of hair one entire bottle of Licener may be required per person. Massage Licener shampoo well into the hair and cover all hair from the scalp to the tips and then leave it in the hair for 10 minutes. If a number of family members have head lice you should try to treat them all on the same day with Licener in order to prevent new infestations.

STEP 2: Rinse out the Licener shampoo. Rinse the shampoo from the hair thoroughly using lukewarm water. Avoid getting shampoo in the eyes, as like all other shampoo this can lead to irritation of the eyes. It is not necessary to wash the hair with a normal shampoo after treatment with Licener. If desired you can comb the hair after treatment to remove dead lice and eggs.

Important

- Licener is suitable for adults and children from 2 years of age. No research has been done with Licener on children under the age of 2;
- Licener should not be used if the person is allergic to any of the ingredients contained in Licener;
- Licener can cause slight eye irritation like any shampoo. Avoid contact with eyes, in case of contact rinse eyes thoroughly with water;
- In case of sensitive or allergic reaction or any other undesirable effect, discontinue use and consult your doctor;
- Do not use if pregnant or likely to become pregnant;
- Please store between 5°C and 25°C;
- Keep out of reach of children;
- For external use only, not to be taken;
- Do not use after the expiry date, see back label.
